MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR APPOINTMENT AS A DOCTORAL FACULTY MEMBER

To apply for a faculty position, applicants must have completed a doctorate or a specialization in medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, or veterinary medicine, or a master's degree in the arts.

For All Disciplines:

- Applicants for Doctoral Faculty positions must give a trial lecture coordinated with the relevant department chair. In case of a tie in points, having taught at a university or vocational school for at least one semester is preferred for initial appointments and is mandatory for reappointments.
- In case of equal scores among candidates, publications in SSCI, SCI, SCI-Expanded, A&HCI, or field-specific indexes, or acceptance of a publication, is a preference.
- In the event of a tie in points among candidates, authorship of an article published in an indexed journal is a preference.
- In the event of a tie in points among candidates, having been a project leader or researcher in an international or national project is a preference criterion.

For Reappointments:

Having taught a minimum number of courses (in accordance with the decision taken in the Higher Education Personnel Law No. 2194 dated 16/9/2005, the minimum course requirement for a semester is to have completed 10 ECTS credits)
